

Tour Summary

East Africa is undoubtedly the greatest visited region on the African continent! It boasts incredible wildlife and showcases one of the most remarkable spectacles in the world, the Great Migration! Apart from this, the area has a deep geological and archaeological history, rich biodiversity, breathtaking landscapes, mesmerizing lake systems and encapsulates some of the most spectacular parks/reserves on earth. Our birding adventure started in the mountains of Arusha National Park, headed West to the baobab country of Tarangire National Park. Continued North up the East Rift Valley escarpment, into the basin of the Ngorongoro Crater, and then to the Acacia and Balanites strewn savanna plains of the

Serengeti National Park. With the Tanzanian leg of the trip done, we crossed North into Kenya via the Namanga border and visited Amboseli National Park at the foothills of Mt. Kilimanjaro. Next, we were off to Mt. Kenya, which hosted a plethora of exciting high altitudinal forest bird species! Heading further North, beyond the equator into thornveld and riverine habitats, we were in Shaba and Buffalo Springs National Reserves looking for rare mammal and bird species! Our adventure concluded at the amazing Lake Nakuru National Park, where we were spoilt with an abundance of waterfowl! This however wasn't our last birding hotspot because we managed to savour a couple of more species before making our way to Nairobi Airport!

Continue reading to see all the highlights we encountered on this unforgettable tour.....

Nestled on the lush slopes of Mt. Meru, our lodge is a great starting point for birders. A welcome dinner was a perfect way to introduce everyone, enjoy the hospitality of the friendly staff and to have a wholesome meal before our travels! The next day we met before sunrise to explore the gardens for some of the specials the tall indigenous trees and permanent lake had to offer. Waller's Starlings, White-eared Barbets and Black-backed Puffbacks were frantically catching the alate emergents that had subsequently exploded after the early morning downpour! We were surprised by the local Black-and-white Colobuses and Blue Monkeys that were already foraging in the trees! The lake offered great views

of Giant Kingfisher, Striated Heron, nesting Taveta Golden and Thick-billed Weavers, a pair of African Black Duck's waddled away close to the edge of the lake, Silvery-cheeked and Crowned Hornbills flew overhead and landed on their favourite trees to feed. We crossed over a bridge to a small patch of forest on the other side of the lake. This is where we had glimpses of Rüpell's Robin-Chats and had our first experience of their incredible mimicry of other forest species! Red-throated Twinspots and Grey-olive Greenbuls were busy feeding in the understory and Brown-throated Barbets were a neck stretch, jumping around, high up in the canopy!

After breakfast and seeing an African Goshawk and African Hobby fly over, we settled our bills and met our esteemed driver/guide Geitan! With our Toyota Landcruiser loaded up, everyone jumped into a seat, and we made tracks to Tarangire National Park! On route we made a few of washroom stops, quickly squeezing in a spot of birding for the likes of Pin-tailed Whydah, Scarlet-chested, Amethyst and Variable Sunbirds, Chestnut Weaver, and Rufous-tailed Weaver (a Tanzania endemic), Kenya Rufous Sparrow (Kenya and Tanzania endemic), Trilling

Cisticola, Southern Red Bishop and several Augur Buzzards were roosting on the Acacias alongside the main road.

Arriving at the gate entrance just after mid-day and feeling a bit peckish, we sat down at the picnic site. Whilst enjoying our lunch, our “heads were on a swivel”, as we were bombarded with bird activity! Ashy Starling, Yellow-collared Lovebird (Tanzania endemics), White-headed Buffalo Weaver, Northern Pied Babbler (Kenya and Tanzania

endemic), Nubian Woodpecker, Mourning Collared Dove were some of the species we had great views of! We also had African White-backed Vultures and Tawny Eagles soaring above us.

The next two nights we stayed at acclaimed Tarangire Safari Lodge with a beautiful, picturesque view of the Tarangire River supported by Baobab and tall Northern Lala Palm trees!

The lodge grounds offered excellent bird species, like nesting Eastern Grey Woodpecker, Bare-faced Go-away-bird, Von der Decken’s Hornbill, Vitelline Masked & Red-headed Weavers, Spotted Morning Thrush, Pearl-spotted Owlet, and resident African Scops Owl. In the evenings we could hear the distant calls of Spotted Hyena, Lions as they walked past camp, and the monotonous slow mechanical alarming call of Slender-tailed Nightjar! Exploring the 2350km² reserve we were delighted to see Banded Parisoma, Red-bellied and Meyer’s Parrots, Red and Yellow-necked Spurfowls, Black-faced Sandgrouse, Two-banded Courser, Buff-crested and White-bellied Bustards, Common Ostrich, Secretarybird, Grey-Crowned Crane, Coqui Francolin, Red-billed and Yellow-billed Oxpeckers, Black-faced Waxbill, Green-winged Pytilia, Red-faced Crombec, Yellow-bellied Eremomela, Reichenow’s Seedeater, Blue-capped and Red-cheeked Cordon-bleus, Steel-blue Whydah, Red-and-yellow and D’Arnaud’s Barbets, Abyssinian Scimitarbill, Green Wood Hoopoe, Olivaceous Warbler, Eastern Violet-backed and Beautiful Sunbirds,

Reedbuck, the diminutive Kirk's Dikdik, Olive Baboon, Vervet Monkey and Maasai Giraffe!

Our journey next took us through some local villages, passing Plain's Zebra, lots of donkeys and a few African Elephant bulls as we ascended the Rift Valley escarpment. At the top we had a panoramic view of Lake Manyara. We then spent two nights at a nearby lodge which allowed us to have a full day in the world's largest caldera, the Ngorongoro Crater! Even though the natural elements were against us, the weather soon cleared up, and we were lucky to see numerous species from the crater rim/viewpoint, through the *Vachellia abyssinica* forest, on the crater floor, and around some of the water bodies. Our top bird species included Grey-capped Warbler, a majestic Crowned Eagle, Eastern Double-collared Sunbird, Hunters and Red-faced Cisticolas, Streaky Seedeater, Cape Robin-Chat, Hildebrandt's Francolin, Red-rumped Swallow, Thick-billed Seedeater, White-eyed Slaty Flycatcher, Tree Pipit, Black and Brown-headed Apalis, Mbulu White-eye, Long-crested Eagle, Red-faced Crimsonwing, Purple Grenadier, Golden-winged and Bronze Sunbirds, Black Cuckooshrike, Black-chested Snake Eagle, Yellow-bellied Waxbill, Red-collared Widowbird, African Marsh Harrier, Winding and Pectoral-patch Cisticola, Southern Citril, Ant-eater Chat, the charismatic Rosy-throated Longclaw, Black-lored Babbler, Dusky Turtle Dove, Jacobin Cuckoo, a flock of Grey-crowned Cranes, an unperturbed Kori Bustard standing right next to the road (a couple of males with their white throat plumes puffed out and tails cocked, advertising to nearby females), Western Yellow Wagtail, Capped Wheatear, lots of waterfowl including Gull-billed Tern, African Swamphen, Saddle-billed Stork, Long-toed and Spur-winged Lapwings, Chestnut-banded Plover, Little Stint, Curlew Sandpiper, hundreds of Greater and Lesser Flamingos changing the dreary water's edge into something more miraculous! Mammal sightings

Eurasian and Black-headed Orioles, Baglafecht weaver, Fischer's sparrow-lark, Flappet lark, Mosque and Red-breasted Swallows, Grey-headed, Woodland and Pygmy Kingfishers, Greater Honeyguide, Levallant's and Common Cuckoo, White-browed Coucal, Bateleur, a melanistic Gabar Goshawk, Eastern and Dark Chanting Goshawks, Martial Eagle, Brown Snake Eagle, Lappet-faced and White-headed Vultures. Mammals included a small pride of lions, Spotted Hyena, herds of African Elephants and Buffalo, Yellow-spotted Rock Hyrax, Unstriped Ground Squirrel, Grant's and Thomson's Gazelle, Common Waterbuck, Bohor





were summed up by a herd of African Buffalo, Common (White-bearded) Wildebeest, Bohor Reedbuck, African Elephant bulls feeding in the marshland, four Lionesses, full bellied resting next to the road and a herd of Common Eland as we exited the conservation area.

Moving onto the Serengeti National Park we drove over the Ngorongoro Crater rim, and this gave us an opportunity to see the striking crimson wings of a Schalow's Turaco as it glided through the forest in clear sunny conditions! Passing the Ngorongoro Crater entrance gate we found Malachite Sunbird, Lyne's Cisticola and a flock of Jackson's Widowbirds around the airstrip before continuing onto the Cradle of Humankind, Oldupai Gorge! Here we had an interesting educational talk by a local guide about the ancient mammal and human remains that were discovered at the site, looked around the museum and had lunch. Black Bishop, White-bellied Canary, Speke's and Vitelline Weavers, Horus and Little Swifts, and Rock Martin were all in the vicinity!

Speeding it up to get to the Serengeti conservation area and driving through dusty Maasai country on corrugated roads, the landscape burst into Acacia woodlands and patches of open areas with a short layer of green grass. The Common Wildebeest migration was in full swing as we drove through thousands upon thousands of animals (including Plain's Zebra and various gazelles) making their way into the Serengeti! We were welcomed by Chestnut-bellied Sandgrouse and a Steppe Eagle at the Serengeti boundary gate. Trying to get to our lodge at a reasonable time we passed by a nesting pair of Lappet-faced Vultures, Greater Kestrel, Abdim's Storks, a large pod of hippos with a sandbank covered in Collared Pratincoles and Water Thick-knees, saw our first Topi, and had distant views of "Coke's" Hartebeest on the plains.

The next three days were spent discovering all the habitats that make the Serengeti so unique! The lodge grounds were productive, not only for bird species but for small mammals too! Acacia Rat, Northern Lesser Galago and Yellow-winged Bat were all found every evening before dinner. Hildebrandt's Starling (Kenya and Tanzania endemic), Slate-coloured Boubou, Meyer's Parrot, Nubian Woodpecker, and Mocking Cliff-Chat were all confiding! Other highlights included Grey-crested Helmetshrike, Red-throated Tit, Usambiro Barbet (Kenya and Tanzania endemics), Grey-breasted Spurfowl (Tanzania endemic), Fischer's Lovebird, Tanzanian Red-billed Hornbill, Eastern Plantain-eater, Black-headed Gonolek, Cardinal Quelea, Pygmy Falcon, Grey-capped Social Weaver, Speckle-fronted Weaver, African and Grey-headed Silverbills, Winding Cisticola, Grey Kestrel, Straw-tailed, Pin-tailed and Long-tailed Paradise Whydahs, Quailfinch, Cut-throat Finch, Cinnamon-breasted and Golden-breasted Buntings, Silverbird, Purple Roller, Orange-breasted Bushshrike, Striped Kingfisher, Green Sandpiper, Grey-backed Fiscal, White-tailed Lark and European Honey Buzzard (from the lodge viewpoint). 
escarpment. Back Arusha for a night, the forest delivered a flock of Trumpeter Hornbills, Kenrick's Starlings, Black-throated Wattle eye and African Wood Owl calling at night.

Into Kenya, we bid farewell to Gaitan and were greeted by Peter our Kenyan driver/guide at Namanga border post. Two nights in Amboseli National Park was our next stop, but a bit of roadside birding and lunch was in order before we arrived at the gate. African Bare-eyed Thrush, White-headed Mousebird, White-bellied Go-away-bird, Rosy-patched Bushshrike, Fischer's Starling and Pink-breasted Lark all showed well. Entering the park, we had a pair of Spotted Eagle-Owls roosting in an Acacia! Africa's iconic Mt. Kilimanjaro stood tall with most of its top covered in clouds! What we thought may be very dry country that had been hit by a serious drought, turned out to be a landscape of wetlands/swamps, short grasslands and palmveld. Notable species with Kilimanjaro as a backdrop, included hundreds of Greater & Lesser Flamingos, Great White Pelican, a Marabou Stork feeding on the head of a catfish, White-winged and Whiskered Terns, hundreds of Red-knobbed Coots, Goliath, Little, Squacco and Black Herons, Malachite, and Pied Kingfishers, Blue-cheeked Bee-eater, Taita Fiscal, Eastern Crombec, Athi Short-toed Lark, Spotted Thick-knee with a chick and a Black Sparrowhawk. We tried hard to call Pangani Longclaw but had no success! Yellow Baboon was a new species of mammal we found everyday close to camp, and we had a brief sighting of a Water Mongoose entering the lodge perimeter fence.

From Amboseli National Park, we headed north via the bustling epicentre of Nairobi, into the highlands of Kenya and stopped at a site for the very localised Hinde's Babbler.

were also lucky to witness a mating pair of Lion putting on a show for us as they copulated for a few seconds and then strutted off into a dense grassland.

Departing the Serengeti for a long day of travel back to Arusha, we spotted Black-bellied Bustards flying over the plains and disappearing instantly as they landed. At Naabi Gate, we looked up in the sky and saw Rüppell's and Hooded Vultures 'kettling' above us looking for their next meal and were surprised to find colourful Mwanza Flat-headed Agamas basking on the washroom walls! The long drive did reward us with Abyssinian Wheatear, in a rocky volcanic quarry descending the

After about an hour of trying to get a babbler to show itself, we had no luck. We did however see a pair of Cinnamon-chested Bee-eaters sitting on the powerlines! Arriving at our rustic lodge in the late afternoon, we had splendid views of Mt. Kenya, Africa's second highest peak. We had good views of Red-fronted Parrot, Hartlaub's Turaco, White-bellied Tit, Northern Double-collared Sunbird, Scarce Swift, and a shy Olive Ibis roosting in a dead tree at dusk! Hudson, the local bird guide took us on two very productive forest walks where we got excellent sightings of the montane specials. Mountain Buzzard, Mountain Oriole, African Hill Babbler, Cinnamon Bracken Warbler, Brown Woodland Warbler, White-tailed Crested Flycatcher, Fine-banded Woodpecker, Kikuyu White-eye (Kenya endemic), Grey, Black-throated, Black-collared, Chestnut-throated and Black-headed Apalises, Eastern Mountain, Slender-billed, Cabanis's and Yellow-whiskered Greenbuls, Mountain Wagtail, Black-fronted Bushshrike, White-starred Robin, Brown-capped Weaver, Grey-headed Nigrita, Jackson's Spurfowl (Kenya and Uganda endemic) and Black-and-white Mannikin. Every evening our huts were warmed up by indoor fires and we could hear the eerie calls of Southern Tree Hyrax above us.

After two epic nights in Mt. Kenya National Reserve, we were on the road again to the lowland Acacia and riverine woodlands of Shaba and Buffalo Springs National Reserves. Along our route and crossing the equator, we stopped for more roadside birding, and struck gold with a scope view of a calling Boran Cisticola!

Three nights at the unbelievable Shaba & Buffalo Springs National

Reserves allowed us to see how rich the area was in unique bird and mammal species! White-throated and Somali Bee-eaters, Vulturine Guineafowl, Eastern Yellow-billed and Jackson's Hornbills, the striking Golden Pipit, Bristle-crowned Starling, Somali Courser, Chestnut-headed Sparrow-Lark, Donaldson Smith's Sparrow-Weaver, Black-capped Social Weaver, Parrot-billed Sparrow, Black-bellied and Hunter's Sunbirds, Somali Ostrich, Somali Bunting, Grey Wren-Warbler, the rare William's and Friedmann's Larks, Golden Palm Weaver, Pale Prinia, Pygmy Batis and Somali Tit were just some of the interesting sightings we encountered! Mammals included the attractive Reticulated Giraffe, the endangered Grevy's Zebra, Beisa Oryx, the bizarre looking Gerenuk, Günther's Dik-dik and Desert Warthog! After a superb time at these magnificent reserves, we made our way southwest to the Great Rift Valley and into Lake Nakuru National Park for a night.

Lake Nakura was jam-packed with waterbirds and had some interesting species on the road and in the Fever Tree grove running alongside the water. Highlights here included Osprey, White-breasted Cormorant, African Darter, Pink-backed & Great White Pelicans, Yellow-billed Stork, Gull-billed Tern, Common Scimitarbill, Greater Blue-eared Starling, Long-tailed Widowbird, Plain-backed Pipit, and Peregrine Falcon. A 'crash' of nine Southern White Rhinoceroses, a 'journey' of the rare, introduced Rothschild's Giraffe, a herd of Common Eland and Plain's Zebra bid us farewell as we departed the park.

On route to Nairobi Airport for our departing flights back home, we stopped at Kinangop Plateau where we had distant views of the endangered Sharpe's Longclaw (localised Kenya endemic) and flushed a couple of African Snipe and Levaillant's Cisticolas from the grasses. Arriving early at the airport, we had a few hours to do a final species checklist update before saying our goodbyes.
