
Veracruz & Eastern Sierras Extension

We started out in Veracruz city and after a leisurely lunch spent the latter part of the afternoon birding the thorn scrub around Miradores. Bird activity was excellent, and it didn't take long to find our two most desired targets with a female Mexican Sheartail perched up nicely in the scope and a confiding group of Veracruz Wrens. Other highlights included a good raptor migration led by Swainson's Hawk, along with Broad-wings and a Zone-tail. Amongst many other species were Couch's Kingbird and Morelet's Seedeater. At dusk we carried on the short distance to Xalapa where we settled in for 3 nights stay.

An early morning departure saw us driving up the flanks of Perote volcano. We spent the first hours of the morning lower down where the cloud forest meets the pine forest. Things were quite lively in these beautiful forests with Hooded Yellowthroat, Black Thrush, Ruddy-capped Nightingale-thrush, Brown-backed Solitaire, Rufous-capped Brushfinch and delightful Golden-browed Warblers amongst numerous highlights. With the day heating up we headed higher up the volcano and in record time secured excellent looks at our main targets of the day: Striped Sparrow, Transvolcanic Jay and a very well-behaved Strickland's Woodpecker. A couple of stunning Red Warblers were also very much appreciated. After a delicious lunch in the old city of Perote we headed north where some time on the plains yielded what appeared to be Chihuahuan Meadowlarks along with the rare and extremely localized Perote Ground Squirrel. Moving on into a spectacular Joshua Tree Forest we continued to add good stuff like Lucifer Hummingbird and the "Sumichrasts" Scrub Jay. A wonderfully varied and beautiful day with views of Perote and Mexico's highest peak, snow clad Orizaba under a blue sky throughout the day.

Our next morning took us to El Haya Park, a lovely greenspace on the edge of Xalapa City. Right out of the vehicle we were soon watching over a dozen overwintering warbler species along with Azure-crowned Hummingbird, White-bellied Emerald and the localized Curve-winged Sabrewing. Slowly ambling through the forest through the morning provided a fantastic selection of birds, most notably Northern Potoo, Blue-capped Motmot, Bronze-winged Woodpecker and Rusty Sparrow. For the afternoon we headed a bit further afield to Chavarillo and while things were rather hot and quiet initially, we found an area of great bird activity which gave us views of Rose-throated Becard, Buff-bellied Hummingbird, Audubon's, and Altamira Oriole and after much persistence an astonishing, Crimson-collared Grosbeak, a male that perched up and gave us memorable views!

back down. Highlights of another excellent morning included Blue Mockingbird, Audubon's Oriole, Yellow-winged Tanager and again a host of overwintering songbirds. Then it was time for the long drive south and west to Tuxtepec. In the late afternoon we decided to explore a wetland system, and this proved to be an excellent idea as the place was full of herons, waterbirds, and a variety of raptors. A female and young male Orchard-type oriole piqued our interest and then suspicions were confirmed when a glorious male Fuertes' Oriole popped out into the open and we enjoyed fantastic views of this poorly known and rarely seen species. With dusk settling in and still some driving to do we pushed on to Tuxtepec.

The following morning, we headed to Bethania and down the bumpy track to a small area of accessible limestone forest. Sumichrast's Wren was our main target here and was notably quiet (probably nesting) but while we searched, we had a great variety of lowland forest birds including Black-faced Grosbeak, Spot-breasted Wren, Black-cowled Oriole, Yellow-bellied Tyrannulet and Blue Ground Dove. It was getting on to late morning and scorching heat when we finally found a silent Sumichrast's Wren hopping along a limestone cliff and showing exceptionally well. It went into a little cave and never came out, presumably where its nest was, and we considered ourselves very fortunate to have had this special encounter. With the temperature now at a scorching 40 degrees Celsius we decided to have an extended siesta and later in the afternoon went out birding a forest patch below Valle Nacional. Bird activity only resumed in the last hour of daylight, but we saw plenty of interesting things like Black-crowned Tityra, Pale-billed Woodpecker, Rufous-breasted Spinetail, Yellow-tailed Oriole and Blue-black Grosbeak.

Our final day of this leg of the tour saw us slowly birding our way from Valle Nacional to the highest part of the road. The lower forests around Valle kept us busy with a nice variety of flycatchers, tanagers, warblers, Black-cowled Oriole, Collared Trogon and White-crowned Parrot. The cloud forest higher up was excellent, and we were serenaded by Slate-colored Solitaires during our time here. Birds came steady in this gorgeous habitat and some highlights included lovely encounters with Bumblebee and Emerald-chinned Hummingbird, a low pair of Blue-crowned Chlorophonia, Unicolored Jay and brief Azure-hooded Jay, a very cooperative Scaly-throated Foliage-gleaner plus Northern Emerald Toucanet and a furtive Middle American Leaffosser. Reaching the high point of the road mid-afternoon we then wound our way down the western side of the range to Oaxaca City.

Oaxaca

We started our time in the Oaxaca Valley in the relative cool of dawn on a scrubby hillside. Exciting new birds came fast and included Bridled Sparrow, White-throated Towhee, Boucard's and Happy Wren and a wonderfully cooperative Pileated Flycatcher belting out its lovely song. Some of the skulkers lived up to their reputations and we worked hard to try and see Ocellated Thrasher and Slaty and Dwarf Vireo all of which showed to varying degrees of success (for now). With a great morning in the books, we enjoyed an exceptional lunch and some mezcal tasting while also getting perfect views of Gray-breasted Woodpecker and Dusky Hummingbird from the lunch table. In the middle of the afternoon, we made a quick check of Yagul and with lots of flowering cacti about and a Beautiful Sheartail calling repeatedly we ended up making a concerted to find this scarce hummer in the hottest part of the day. Fortunately, we found a shady willow to wait under while the sheartail made a few quick visits to a flowering cactus although views were not the best. We then visited Eric's village for a fascinating rug weaving demonstration before returning to our comfortable hotel near the city centre.

Another early start was to cross the Sierra Juarez and drop into the southern end of the Balsas drainage. The scrubby vegetation here provided us with some excellent birding. Ocellated Thrasher were more cooperative

this morning and we enjoyed prolonged scope views of one along with a pair of "Dickey's" Audubon's Oriole. Slaty Vireo showed really well for everyone, and Oaxaca Sparrow put on show as well. A pair of Rusty-crowned Ground Sparrows were a great bonus. Nearby we found a fruiting fig tree that was full of Rufous-backed Thrushes, a Blue Mockingbird, some West Mexican Chachalacas and even a pair of Elegant Trogons. Cinnamon-rumped Seedeaters were feeding out in the field, and we finally tracked down a perched Beautiful Sheartail for some excellent viewing after much work on seeing this one. It was an extremely productive morning and then we headed up into the Juarez range where we had an early lunch as we enjoyed Blue-throated Mountaingems and Rufous-capped Brushfinches at close range. We then headed deep into the pine/oak forests where it did not take too long at to track down a flock of about 15 Gray-barred Wrens that were being accompanied by a few Dwarf Jays. Excellent! We

also had great views of Collared Towhee, Red Warbler and Mexican Chickadee before heading back down the mountains to the city. Another full and successful day of birding.

We then returned to Teotitlan del Valle and birded the road heading up to Benito Juarez. It took a lot of work, but we eventually got good views of Dwarf Vireo and then we headed higher up to the pine/oak forests where it was dry and fairly quiet, but we managed to find almost all of the hoped for species up here: Chestnut-sided Shrike Vireo, White-striped Woodcreeper, Mountain Trogan, Mexican Violetear, Red-faced Warbler and Painted Whitestart being among the main highlights. After a picnic lunch we slowly worked our way back down the mountain and ended up in the city mid-afternoon for a little break before heading out for a walk through the downtown area and our finest meal of the trip in the food capital of Mexico.

Our final morning based in Oaxaca we headed up to the Monte Alban ruins. Birding was productive with Blue Mockingbird, Orange-billed Nightingale-thrush and Black-vented Oriole amongst the highlights while Eric gave us a detailed run through of the archaeology and history as we wandered the vast and picturesque archaeological site. We continued to a lovely lunch spot and then eventually worked our way up out of the Oaxaca Valley and into the Sierra Madre del Sur. Once we arrived at the cool pine/oak zone we made a couple of stops in search of White-throated Jay. No luck there but we did have a wide range of overwintering warblers and some excellent hummingbirds including White-eared, Garnet-throated, Rivoli's, Bumblebee, plus Blue-throated Mountaingem. We arrived at our cosy cabins with a bit of daylight left to enjoy some light birding and excellent scenery before heading into town to a cosy little Italian restaurant with huge portions. Back in our cabins Mexican Whip-poor-wills serenaded us to sleep.

After breakfast we wandered the grounds of our lodge enjoying nice views of Hooded Yellowthroat, Broad-tailed Hummingbird, Black-vented Oriole, Cinnamon-bellied Flowerpiercer and various other confiding species. Just as we were preparing to leave Eric pointed out the slurred calls of Aztec Thrush and, extraordinarily, within a couple of seconds there was a pair of Aztec Thrushes sitting in a tree over our head. We were so truly fortunate to get to spend a

few minutes watching these fantastic birds. Their nomadic and unpredictable nature makes them one of the hardest of Mexican birds to see. And they are quite unique, being of a monotypic genus. Somewhat in shock with our good fortune, we now set out in search of another of Mexico's hardest birds, White-throated Jay. It didn't take long to hear them, but they remained hidden, so we continued our search getting excellent views of the well-marked "Violet-throated" race of Amethyst-throated Mountain-gem and Red Warbler as we searched. Finally, after a concerted effort we heard some more White-throated Jays and then suddenly they popped up in the pines at eye level giving us quite amazing viewing as a trio of them moved through the area. Returning to our lodge we stopped for a Middle American Gopher Snake crossing the road and then re-found it in the forest where it gave very close views, especially to Josh!! Probably the most exciting morning of the trip! We returned to the lodge and after lunch set off on the rather long drive down to the Pacific coast. Arriving to the middle elevations of the mountains we took a bathroom stop and were suddenly surrounded by birds including Golden Vireo, a dozen Red-legged Honeycreepers and various warblers, vireos and orioles. In rapid succession three of the area's trickiest specialties showed up each offering great views: Oaxaca Hummingbird, Golden-crowned Emerald, and Gray-crowned Woodpecker. Really phenomenal stuff and quite the pitstop! With nice cool overcast conditions, we continued to bird the area above Pluma Hidalgo for a couple hours before continuing all the way down to the coast and settling in for a 4-night stay in the tidy village of Huatulco.

The next morning was spent slowly birding our way up from the coast back into the mountains towards Pluma Hidalgo. Birds were plentiful in the varied habitats along the road and some side tracks including Citreoline

Trogon and Russet-crowned Motmot. We found a sweet spot in a gully off the road that had a perched Mexican Hermit, a very well-behaved Oaxaca Hummingbird plus Fan-tailed Warbler and Banded Wren. Wagler's Toucanet were furtive here but a bit further up the road cooperated very nicely as we scoped one up for as long as we wanted. Eventually we did arrive up to Pluma Hidalgo for a tasty lunch and a good cup of coffee before wandering around looking for Red-headed Tanager. It took quite a while to find one and when we did, we followed it back all the way to the restaurant where it gave excellent views. We scanned for swifts from a few vantage points seeing many White-collared Swifts and then slowly made our way

back down towards the hotel having had yet another excellent day's birding.

We then set out for our pelagic trip. Leaving the harbour, we soon had a breaching Humpback Whale, mobula rays leaping from the water, our first of many Olive Ridley Turtles and even a breaching Thresher Shark for some. The huge feeding flocks of shearwaters and dolphins that can be here were nowhere to be found (due to a warmer water current in the area according to the skipper) and so we pushed on into a little deeper water where it was slow but steady action all morning. Storm-petrels were particularly prominent, and we had large numbers of Black and Least with several Wedge-rumped as well. Of the shearwaters there were a few Wedge-tailed and Pink-footed while Black-vented and Galapagos showed only once each and quite distant. We also found a large playful pod of Bottlenose Dolphin, a few Sabine's Gull, a Pomarine Jaeger, a few Brown Booby and some Pantropical Spotted Dolphin on the way in. A really solid pelagic! After a beachside seafood lunch in the late afternoon, we birded a track in Huatulco National Park where we tracked down a lovely, Red-breasted Chat to round off the day nicely.

Our final day's birding saw us exploring the dry forest habitats of Huatulco. We were able to spend the morning in a private property where it was relatively lush and heaving with birds especially in the early morning hours. Highlights included large numbers of Orange-breasted Bunting, Turquoise-crowned Hummingbird, Golden-cheeked Woodpecker, Sclater's Wren, and several endangered Lilac-crowned Amazons. Continuing through the forest we found another Red-breasted Chat and eventually tracked down a tooting Colima Pygmy Owl for lovely views. Eric's friends had a delicious spread for us late morning and then we returned to town for an extended siesta during the hottest part of the day. We headed back into the national park late afternoon and while we could not find the Flammulated Flycatcher we were searching for; we were more than compensated by a spectacular Lesser Ground Cuckoo that froze on an open patch of ground with its wings spread out and then crept through some sparse thickets and somehow disappeared. We stayed out till dark where we heard Pacific Screech Owl at close quarters but could not see before having a final meal together celebrating the end of a memorable trip.
