Kenya & Tanzania Birds & Big Game IV *4th to 21st May 2018 (18 days)* Trip Report

Tour Summary

Our tour started off in the capital city of Kenya, Nairobi. We visited iconic destinations such as Mount Kenya, Shaba and Buffalo Springs Game Reserves, Lake Nakuru and Amboseli with Mount Kilimanjaro as a backdrop! Our adventure then took us into the wilderness of Tanzania. Tarangire National Park, with its beautiful scenery and hundreds of African Elephants between the myriad of Baobab Trees; Ngorongoro Crater, with one of the highest densities of predators in the world; and lastly the Serengeti, where we witnessed the great migration – hundreds of thousands of wildebeest and zebra marching over the open plains. We managed to find the iconic “Big 5” on our Safari and even witnessed a Cheetah kill on our last day in the Serengeti! The birding did not take a back seat at all, and we had superb sightings and tallied a total of 477 species on our Safari!

waterhole which had floodlights on at night. This gave us the opportunity to encounter some tough to find mammals, such as Giant Hog, White-tailed Mongoose and even a Leopard for some. A highlight was watching African Buffalo every day, as well as a herd of African Elephants quenching their thirst one early evening. Birding here was superb, and a guided walk into the forest saw us finding many specials like Black-throated, Chestnut-throated and Grey Apalises, Kikuyu White-eye, the superb Narina Trogon, Olive-breasted and Placid Greenbuls, Crowned Hornbill, the outrageous African Emerald Cuckoo and Silvery-cheeked Hornbill. Hartlaub's Turaco was a special here, and we found many birds affording us great looks.

From here we ventured down the escarpment to the drier regions of the north. Shaba and Buffalo Springs Game Reserves with Samburu Game Reserve on their borders was our playground for the next three days. We had the opportunity to

We met at our conveniently situated hotel for our first night before departing the next morning, making our way north to Mount Kenya. We had some great birding on route, visiting a small wetland where we raked up some good birds, such as Holub's Golden, Eastern Golden and Thick-billed Weavers, Black Crake, Red-billed Firefinch, Spotted Mourning Thrush, White-browed Robin-Chat and Lesser Swamp Warbler. Our journey north saw us buying some fresh mangos before we arrived at Mount Kenya. *The second highest summit in Africa created a beautiful backdrop for our escapades.* Our lodge was set on the edge of a

connect with many species more adapted to the drier environs, such as the outrageous Vulturine Guineafowl, Somali Bee-eater, Lichtenstein's Sandgrouse, Somali Courser, Red-winged, Pink-breasted and Foxy Larks, Golden-breasted, Magpie and Fischer's Starlings, Mouse-colored Penduline Tit, Golden Palm Weaver, Fan-tailed Raven, Northern Puffback, Pygmy Batis, Three-streaked Tchagra, Rufous Chatterer, Green-capped and Yellow-vented Eremomelas, Northern Crombec, the beautiful

rare Striped Hyaena! The scenery here was fantastic, with many new bird species too. Notable mentions must go to a *gabonensis* sub-species of Black Cuckoo, Greater Blue-eared Starling, Great White Pelican, African Spoonbill, Broad-billed Roller, Mosque Swallow, African Thrush in the lodge gardens and also Hildebrandt's Francolin.

We left Lake Nakuru and made our way south. En route we made a stop to find a localised bird, Sharpe's Longclaw, which we found very quickly. We ventured back through Nairobi and onwards to Amboseli Game Reserve on the border of Tanzania. Mount Kilimanjaro was extremely cooperative, as the cloud cover gave way multiple times to enable us views of its summit. *This created a fantastic backdrop indeed.* Upon entering the reserve, we managed to find a roosting Spotted Eagle-Owl, which was a good start. Other fantastic species were the rare Fire-fronted Bishop, as well as the outrageous Golden Pipit. Our safaris here showed us fantastic sightings of Hippopotami out of the water, African Elephants, as well as a rare Side-striped Jackal! The amount of water from some heavy rains had blocked off many roads, but this had a huge perk in terms of waterbirds! We found many Long-toed and Spurwing Lapwings, Chestnut-banded, Common Ringed and Kittlitz's Plovers, Greater and Lesser Flamingos, Collared Pratincole, Saddle-billed and Yellow-billed Storks, Yellow-throated Sandgrouse and even Dwarf Bittern!

Rosy-patched Bushshrike, Tsavo, Black-bellied and Hunters Sunbirds, as well as a surprise Friedmann's Lark – *which is extremely sought-after*. Mammals were also a feature here, and we raked up species such as the odd Gerenuk, Reticulated Giraffe, Grevy's Zebra, Desert Warthog and Beisa Oryx!

Lake Nakuru was our next stop for one night, and we had extreme luck after some rain. We managed to find a beautiful Leopardess in a tree very close to us, as well as the extremely

Our time in Kenya had unfortunately already come to an end as we made our way across the Namanga border post. We made our way to the spectacular Tarangire National Park and managed to find an extremely sought-after bird en route, Scaly Chatterer! Upon arriving in Tarangire, we found our first specials, Yellow-collared Lovebird and Ashy Starling! This reserve has got some of the best scenery in Africa, with its myriad of Baobabs, and a good elephant population to boot. Our lodge provided us with some great sightings of Kirk's Dik-dik, Yellow-spotted Hyrax and some stunning Common Agamas. Doing our safaris around the park saw us finding Von Der Decken's and Northern Red-billed Hornbills, Southern Ground Hornbill, Rufous-tailed Weaver, Grey Kestrel, Blue-cheeked Bee-eater, Pygmy Falcon, Bronze-winged Courser, Slate-colored Boubou, Banded Parisoma, Northern Pied Babbler, Pearl-spotted Owlet, Beautiful Sunbird, Martial Eagle, Freckled Nightjar, White-headed Barbet, African Scops Owl and both Red-and-yellow and D'Arnaud's Barbets.

We then left the Great Rift Valley and made our way up to the world-famous Ngorongoro Crater. We spent a lot of time exploring the rim of the crater with many new forest species. Highlights included Grey Cuckoo-shrike, Schalow's Turaco, Mountain Buzzard, Crowned Eagle, Brown-headed Apalis, Mountain Greenbul, Montane White-eye, White-tailed Blue Flycatcher, Green-backed Honeybird, Yellow-bellied Waxbill, Golden-winged, Malachite, Tacazze and Bronze Sunbirds, Brown Parisoma, Grey-capped Warbler, Singing and Hunter's Cisticolas, White-eyed Slaty Flycatcher and Thick-billed Seedeater. Our full day down in the crater was superb. We had many sightings of Lion, Black Rhinoceros, African Buffalo, African Elephant, Common Wildebeest, Plains Zebra, Common Eland,

Spotted Hyaena and both Thompson's and Grant's Gazelles. A memorable sighting down here was many Jackson's Widowbirds displaying! Hopping up and down showing off their tail plumes was truly special to watch. We also encountered Greater Honeyguide, Rosy-throated Longclaw and Black-bellied Bustard. The view overlooking the crater from our lodge was insanely beautiful, especially around sunset.

We then skirted the rim of the crater and made our way down towards the Serengeti – meaning open plains in Swahili. Our first stop was a local Masai


Village within the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. These people live in harmony with nature and are allowed to occupy this protected area because of this – also because it is their custom to not eat any

wildlife but rather their own livestock. We had a great time watching their welcoming ceremony which consisted of a dance. Their way of life was also interesting to see. We then visited Oldupai Gorge, a special site for Archaeology, especially because of the discovery of some early hominids here. The Serengeti was superb to say the least. Besides the fantastic birding, we witnessed the Great Migration! Hundreds of thousands of wildebeest and zebra dotted the horizon, and a little further on we witnessed a large herd of wildebeest moving. Thousands of individuals walked in single file and spanned the horizon from left to right. *It was truly spectacular to witness.*

We spent two full days in the Serengeti and even made our way to the western corridor to look for some specials. Here, we managed to find Brown-throated Wattle-eye, Eastern Plantain-eater, Black-headed Gonolek and a surprise Western Banded Snake Eagle! Some memorable mammal sightings included many Leopards, Lions, Golden and Black-backed Jackals, African Elephants, African Buffalo, Topi and Hartebeest. Other fine bird species included the rare Grey-crested Helmetshrike, Long-tailed, Croaking, Winding, Rattling, Desert, Pectoral-patch and Zitting Cisticolas, Red-fronted Barbet, White-bellied Canary, Purple Grenadier, Ruppell's, White-backed, White-headed, Hooded and Lappet-faced Vultures, Red-throated Tit, Dark Chanting, Eastern Chanting and Gabar Goshawks, Abyssinian Scimitarbill and many “buffalo-wings”, more commonly known as White-headed and Red-billed Buffalo Weavers.

The time had come to leave the Serengeti, and upon our departure we witnessed a Cheetah making a kill! It was so surreal we could not believe our eyes, let alone snap any photographs! The chase seemed like play until the male Cheetah got closer to a herd of Common Wildebeest. Its slow run turned into true speed – *fantastic to watch!* It then tackled a young wildebeest and pinned it down. The adrenaline pumped through our veins, and we were just watching the spectacle! This was a fantastic way to end our time in this true wilderness!

We stayed on the edge of Mount Meru for our last night. Situated in the forest,

this was a great way to end our safari. We had some lengthy walks in the forest and managed to rake-up many new birds. These included Stripe-faced, Grey-olive and Little Greenbuls, Retz's

Helmetshrike, Green Malkoha, Red-throated Twinspot, Brown-hooded Kingfisher, Scarce Swift, Grey Tit-Flycatcher and Yellow-fronted Canary. We had a great lunch before departing and making our way back home after a very memorable safari to Africa!
